5. What are some ways that this could be remedied?
6. May you be wise like the Locusts by not tackling life alone. It's one thing to have friends that you spend time with, but another to invite those friends into your faith walk at a deep level. To what degree do you believe you've opened significant dialogue about your faith with brothers and sisters in Christ?
7. Why is this difficult or easy for you?
8. May you be wise like the Lizard by being bold and persistent in your pursuit of God. What do you think this looks like?
9. How does this section of scripture cause you to think about God differently as creator?
10. How does this scripture cause you to view creation differently?
